

The Dominican Republic is a recognized tourist destination with an abundance of natural beauty, a truly exotic and exuberant flora and fauna, forests and mangroves, rivers and miles of coastline beaches, natural springs and waterfalls, pleasant tropical weather, rich cultural heritage and joyful people.

LOCATION/GEOGRAPHY:

The country occupies the eastern two-thirds of the island of La Hispaniola, which it shares with Haiti, and is the second largest country in the Caribbean, comprising an area of 48,442 square kilometers (29,948 square miles). It is bordered on the north by the Atlantic Ocean and on the south by the Caribbean Sea. Approximately nine million people live in the Dominican Republic.

POPULATION:

The population of the Dominican Republic is more than 8.5 million people.

TIME ZONE:

Clocks are Atlantic Standard all year long one hour ahead of those on the US eastern seaboard in the fall – winter but keep the same time in the spring – summer. The Dominican Republic is four hours behind Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

CAPITAL CITY:

The capital of the Dominican Republic is Santo Domingo, which is the oldest city in the new world. It has a population of almost 2.5 million people.

GOVERNMENT:

The Dominican Republic's political structure is based on democratic principles. Every four years the country elects its president, vice president and legislators.

LANGUAGE:

Spanish is the official language of the Dominican Republic although English is widely spoken, especially in tourist areas and large cities. Traffic sign are in Spanish, although menus in tourist regions are usually also available in English.

CURRENCY:

The Dominican Peso (RD\$) is the official currency of the Dominican Republic. You can find out the exchange rate at www.xe.com/ucc. Major credit cards and travelers' checks are accepted at many of the country's tourist locations;

CLIMATE:

The temperatures usually fluctuate from a high of 33oC (91oF) in August a chilly 17oC (62oF) on winter mornings. Temperatures between summer and winter usually fluctuate less than ten degrees.

TRANSPORTATION:

The country posses a modern airport system, comfortable and efficient, composed of six airports located throughout the national geography for domestic and international flights. Cap Cana is only ten minutes away from the Punta Cana international airport. For ground transportation you can either rent a car upon your arrival at the airport or use a taxi service that can be provided by hour or day.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS:

The country has one of the most sophisticated telecommunications systems in Latin America that is provided by Claro Codetel, Tricom, Orange and Viva. Dialing to the United States requires +1 and to Europe and Asia +011.

TAX AND TIPS:

All services provided such as restaurants and hotels collect by law a 28% of their published prices, 18% for the sales tax and 10% service charge. Its customary to tip an additional 10% for satisfactory service in restaurants.

WATER:

While in the Dominican Republic it is recommended that you drink bottled or treated water. You will be served bottled water at restaurants. Do not drink tap water.

DRESS CODE:

Bathing suits and other beachwear are considered appropriate on the beach at the pool or on a boat. Topless bathing and nudity on the beach and pools are frowned upon.



BOAT RECEPTION HOURS:

Dominican Maritime Law states that boats may not arrive before 6:00 am hours or after 6:00 pm. Please contact the Harbor Office at least 60 minutes prior to arriving.

AFTFR-HOURS:

After-hour arrivals and departures can be authorized by the Dominican navy, please contact our office.

BERTHS:

Mega yacht berths maximum length 190 feet.

BEAM:

Eight feet (8').

MAINTENANCE AND TECHNICAL SERVICES:

Our premier facility can assist you in finding technicians that can complete maintenance repairs, renovations or upgrades to any part of your vessel. We have a line-up of top-notch sub-contractors who specialize in everything from marine electronics and mechanics to refrigeration, air conditioning and painting.

Marina Cap Cana comprises three jetties, which currently provide 106 berthing spaces, the majority of which have 40 foot finger piers. The marina caters to vessels up to 190' in length with a maximum of 8 ft. draft. Each berth provides electrical accommodations of up to 308 volts, three phase - 100 amps and 50 amps as well as the standard 110/220 volt, 30 and 50 amp single phase and three phase, additionally, water, and cable TV hookups are provided at each berth and enjoy of complimentary Wi-Fi.








PART OF INFINITI'S 2014 LINE

DRY DOCK:

The marina offers dry dock services at convenience rates.

At the Marina you can find Multiple Bank BDI, the bank is open daily from Monday to Thursday 8:30 am to 4:00 pm Friday 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. There is also a 24 hour ATM. Outside the marina you can find mayor Dominican commercial banks.

weekly forecasts are mailed to our entire Marina guest. Hurricane season starts on June and ends in november. However Marina Cap Cana's design is the safest of the whole island.












In its 2014 fishing season of 232 days a whopping 2,632 billfish were released which of this total fishing crews mingled with 1,033 blue marlins, 1,535 white marlins, 60 sailfish and 4 spears; averaging an outstanding 11 bills per day.



BANKS:


BDI Bank at Marina Cap Cana is open Monday thru Friday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm and on Saturdays until 1:00 pm. Most ATMs operate on Cirrus (MasterCard) or Plus (Visa) networks. Money withdrawn from ATMs in the DR will be paid in Dominican pesos; you will find an ATM machine at the marina and another one in Ciudad Las Canas.

CONVENTION AND MEETING FACILITIES:


There are several convention and meeting facilities inside our resort, where you could organize any desired activity of your convenience.

MARINA CAP CANA GREEN RULES

Marina Cap Cana cares for the preservation of the marina sea and the beautiful coral reefs.

Knowing that nearly 26 percent of the world's existing coral reefs are severely damaged and another 32 percent may be lost, we are aware that these activities are especially sensitive to reef degradation.

Because we will love to have you as a visitor for many more years, please help us preserve the natural environment by following our green rules:

- ❖ Do not disturb or harass marine life or remove marine life from its natural habitat or shells
- ♦ Do not step on or touch coral. Use of anchors is only permitted in sand and in case of emergencies
- ♦ Do not throw cigarette butts, fishing line, plastic bags, bottles and garbage in the sea they are dangerous to sea life
- ♦ Marina Cap Cana encourages the use of biodegradable boating supplies
- ❖ Water quality impacts all sea life. For the disposal of chemicals such as oil, fuel, tar, paint, antifouling, bleach or sewage, use the receptacles provided for this matter. Under no circumstance should these be disposed in the sea water.
- ♦ Fish waste must be disposed onshore, not on the water
- ❖ Keep your engine well tuned to prevent fuel and oil leaks
- ♦ Conserve water when rinsing boats, do not waste freshwater

- ♦ According to international regulations, you must be three miles off shore before emptying holding tanks
- ♦ Avoid disturbing seafloor vegetation with outboard motor propellers. It may cause shoreline erosion and impact marine habitats
- ♦ Please be aware that the reefs of Cap Cana have been declared catch and release fishing zone. Fishing inside reef is limited exclusively to licensed fishermen.
- ♦ In 2008, the lionfish began to populate the reefs of the Dominican Republic. This predator can consume as many as 20 native fish in half an hour and can reduce the local biodiversity, the region has established some actions to control this specie. By fishing lionfish, you will help us control the threat of the lionfish to Dominican coral reefs
- ♦ When buying souvenirs we recommend you avoid the purchase of coral or conch made gifts. Please be aware that in some countries you will not be allowed to enter with these items.

The Dominican Republic protects endangered species, when in the Dominican waters please take in to consideration the restrictions established by law:

- ♦ Respect the reproductive period of endangered marine life. The law establishes a ban for lobster from March 1st to June 30th and for conch from July 1st to October 31st.
- ♦ The hunt of marine mammals such as manatee and humpback whales is banned year-round.
- \diamondsuit It is prohibited by law the hunt of marine turtles and their eggs.

MARINA ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

If you are planning to visit the Dominican Republic, you should take into consideration that most nationalities require a valid passport, international visitors have to clear Immigration and Customs.

The first thing you will need to do is contact the Marina de Guerra (Dominican Navy) on VHF 16 and then the Capitania's on VHF 72 and wait for authorities to complete the check-in process.

The Harbor Master will welcome you on your boat to start the Dominican Navy registration process including Customs, Immigration, and other government agency requirements. Do not disembark without the authorities' permission.

Dominican Maritime Law does not allow arrivals or departures before 06:00 or after 18:00 hours except with a special authorization from the Dominican Navy under emergencies and special circumstances. All paperwork will be conducted by government representatives at the Harbor Master's Office where you will receive a specific receipt for every transaction. If at any time a Naval, Drugs, Agricultural, or sanitation official needs to board your boat, the presence of the Harbor Master and Navy Commandant is necessary.

PROCEDURES FOR ARRIVAL AT THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

- ♦ All fees must be paid in cash US\$ or Dominican Pesos
- ❖ Please have all passports and vessel documentation ready for inspection
- ♦ If you would like an interpreter, please call the Harbor Master office on VHF 72
- ♦ Dominican Navy, Customs and drug enforcement officials reserve the right to search your vessel
- ♦ Do not be afraid to require officials to remove their shoes before boarding
- ❖ Tipping is optional and should never be implied by officials

PROCEDURES FOR DEPARTURE AT THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

- ♦ Customs, Immigration, DNCD and Dominican Navy will re-board the vessel
- → Pay only US \$20 to the Dominican Navy officials –
 Marina de Guerra for vessel departure
- ♦ If your stay is a month or longer, you should pay US
 \$ 25 immigration for international departure

SAFETY IN THE MARINA

In case of emergency dial 711 from a landline phone at Cap Cana, state the nature of the emergency, your location and the telephone number or the property you are calling from. Contact the Capitania on VHF 72 or dial 1 809.227.2262. Please read the following safety notes.

GENERAL SAFETY IN THE MARINA

- ❖ First aid is available at Capitania and at Cap Cana's Medical Service.
- ♦ Report all accidents and potential hazards to the Capitania's immediately.
- ♦ Do not allow your vessel's anchors and davits to overhang walkways. Only drop your anchor in case of emergencies.
- ♦ Do not travel above three knots in the Marina do not create wash.
- ♦ Do not swim, fish, or dive in the Marina
- ♦ Children should wear suitable life jackets and be supervised when near water
- ♦ Keep clear of vessels and the area involved in lifting operations.
- ♦ Use rescue equipment only in the event of an emergency. Advise the Harbor Master's Office if you use any of the equipment. Rescue equipment is provided for use in emergencies. Misuse of this equipment may have life-threatening ramifications for future users.
- ♦ Use of bicycles and golf carts is allowed on the jetties. Please use caution and do not travel at excessive speed
- ♦ Ensure that you use the correct size and quantity of mooring line for your boat.
- ♦ Do not remove supports from vessels in the yard.
- ♦ Have electrical leads checked by a qualified person on a regular basis.
- ♦ Do not sail or row boats in the Marina.
- ♦ Wave runners / Jet skis: because it is important to maintain the pristine natural and peaceful environment

and do to the safety of beach swimmers the Dominican Republic law has banned the use of wave runners/jet skis. The penalties for using jet skis / waves runners are a \$5,000 fine.

FIRE SAFETY IN THE MARINA

- ♦ Locate and note the position of Fire Emergency Stations.
- ♦ At the Fuel Station: No smoking. Turn off mobile phones, VHF radios, engines and cooking appliances.
- ♦ Keep minimum stores of gasoline, diesel, and propane gas.
- ♦ Installing a smoke detector is the simplest step you can take to reduce the risk of fire. Test regularly.
- ♦ Ensure all gas installations are in sound condition and checked regularly by a qualified contractor. Make sure your propane tank is secured and kept away from heat sources. Check that your fire extinguisher and fire blanket are serviceable.
- ♦ Always isolate fuel on leaving your vessel
